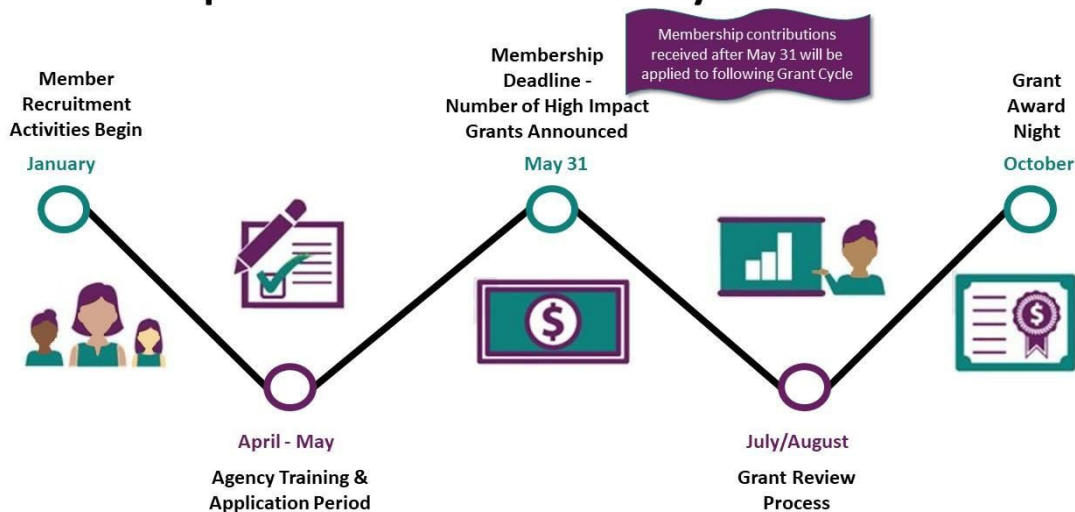
Spring Fling coming up May 10

Agency update: Nonprofits work together to help kids experience nature



Every Friday, a small group of youth from Roy Maas Youth Alternatives' Oaks Academy Campus in Boerne travels by bus to the nearby Herff Farm at the Cibolo Center for Conservation. There, the students tend a large garden where they grow food from seed to harvest while they enjoy healing time in nature.
